## SURE Network Curriculum Project



The SURE Network was established in 2017 by a community of Institutes of Technology committed to enhancing practice in undergraduate research in the Sciences. Its activities are:

**Conferences:** The SURE Network implements a series of annual regional undergraduate conferences. Three conferences took place in 2018 - in Dublin (DIT, IT Tallaght, DKIT), Athlone (AIT, GMIT, IT Sligo) and Waterford (WIT, CIT, IT Carlow). The conferences – which ran concurrently on 28<sup>th</sup> September 2018 - showcased the research work undertaken by students who completed their studies in 2018. Final year STEM students formed the audience and participated in workshops that provided them with guidance on conducting high quality research. The 2019 conferences will take place in TU Dublin, IT Sligo and IT Carlow on 27<sup>th</sup> September 2019.

**Journal:** Presenters at the conferences are invited to submit a paper to the SURE Undergraduate Research Journal, published online and edited by the SURE Network. This journal is launching in 2018.

**Curriculum Development:** The SURE Network is researching and developing models for the effective integration of research into the undergraduate curriculum in the Sciences. This has commenced with a national survey of models for the implementation of final year projects in the Sciences.

The SURE Network is supported by the National Forum for the Enhancement of Teaching and Learning in Higher Education.
